



# Magnetic fly screen assembly instructions

Each fly screen kit contains the following items which will build 1 complete fly screen



4 corner pieces



Mesh insertion tool



4 magnets and screws



Fly mesh



Rubber beading



4 sections of Aluminium framing cut to size



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1. The frame will come pre cut to your ordered sizes.



2. Assemble the frame by pushing the corner pieces into the frame, you may need to tap these in using a hammer.



3. Lay the assembled frame on a flat surface with the inner groove facing you. Place the mesh over the panel and start to push the rubber gasket into the groove using the tool supplied. Trim off any excess mesh with a sharp Stanley knife.



4. You will then have the assembled panel.

5. Place the panel over the window opening in the desired position and mark the position of the corners with a pencil.

Remove the screen and the screw the magnets x 4 into the positions marked, corresponding with the corners. It is best not to over tighten the screws and to allow the magnets slight movement. Place the panel over the window and it will snap onto the magnets holding it in position.



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## SAFETY NOTICE

Please read and follow these guideline instructions for handling the magnets

Recommendations on Handling Magnets Safely

Wear eye protection and work gloves (if necessary) when working with magnets.

Pay close attention when you are separating or handling magnets.

To separate magnets, grasp the outside magnet, slide it off the stack and pull it away quickly.

Work on a metal table or surface, so that magnets stay where you set them, or place the magnets far apart so that they can't jump together.

When you have magnets in both hands, remember to keep your hands far apart.

Do not drill or machine neodymium magnets.

Neodymium magnets will retain their magnetism and integrity for decades when handled, utilized and protected properly.
